Qualifications:

1. The teacher nominated must be directly involved in Pre K - 12 classroom instruction in a public rural school.
2. The individual may be nominated only for his/ her position or role in rural education.
3. To be eligible for consideration as the RSANY RURAL TEACHER OF THE YEAR, nominees must hold a Pre-K-12 teaching position in New York during the previous year and maintain appropriate NYS certification.
4. Each section of the application packet has a maximum length requirement.
5. Letter of recommendation should be double spaced on letterhead or personal stationery.
6. Each application response should be double-spaced, on one side only, with one-inch margins, on 8.5 x 11 inch, white paper, and may not use a font size smaller than 12 point.
7. The applicant's name must appear on every page of the application packet and pages numbered (upper right corner preferred).
8. All materials should be emailed to rsa@rsany.org.
9. Upon selection as RSANY Rural Teacher of the Year, the nominee agrees to work in collaboration with their school and RSANY to complete the National Rural Teacher of the Year Application - nrea.net
10. Understand that this designation may result in the expectation of your presence and participation at various conferences and events.

Section 2. LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

One letter of recommendation is required in addition to the nominator's letter of recommendation. The letter of recommendation could come from any of the following categories; Administrator, Teacher, Community Member, Parent, and Student. Please address letters to "Rural Schools Association of New York Teacher of the Year Committee."

The letter of recommendation is limited to a maximum of one page (double spaced).

Section 3. BACKGROUND NARRATIVE

This is where the nominee describes background, experiences, and activities related to exceptional performance in the educational system/building or district. This could include biographical information, educational background, action photos, awards, honors, community recognition, etc. The maximum length is two double-spaced pages. When submitting your narrative to support your candidacy, please consider including the elements listed below.
